

## **New for 2011**

### **Common Crop Insurance Policy**

This new policy will combine the coverage you currently have under CRC and APH into one policy and one policy form. It will also incorporate other coverages such as Revenue Assurance and Indexed Income Protection. The policy will provide either revenue based coverage or yield based coverage.

The policies you currently have will be automatically rolled into this new format, so there is nothing you need to do at this time. If you have corn insured under CRC, it will be rolled into revenue coverage. If you have corn insured under APH, it will be rolled into the yield coverage.

### **2011 Quotes**

Your quotes may look different this fall. Be on the lookout for them during the first couple of weeks in September. If you have questions about them, please call. We will be happy to go over them with you. We will be posting a sample for you to take a look at as soon as we are able to quote 2011 crops.

### **Acreage Reporting**

Starting this fall, you are required to report your acreage by field. There will be new reporting forms. Prior to planting this fall, we will send you what is known as an acreage reporting booklet. This booklet will include maps for each farm currently listed on your policy and you will be able to mark your acres and plant dates right on these maps.

### **Reporting Booklets**

We recommend you keep them with you and record the information as you plant.

There is a map included for each farm serial number. Simply record the crop and plant date on each field shown on the map. If a field is missing on the map, make a note of it so nothing is missed when it is reported.

Under each map you will see a section for each crop you have insured. Please record the acres and plant date there for each field.

Sign and date where indicated on the last page and return the entire book to us. This will be considered your actual acreage report.
